- Judas betrays Jesus, and the guards arrest Him³¹

Friday (pre-dawn)

APRIL 3RD IN AD 33 •15TH OF NISAN

- Peter denies Jesus the first time³²
- Annas questions Jesus³³
- Peter denies Jesus the second time³⁴
- Peter denies Jesus the third time³⁵
- The Sanhedrin tries Jesus³⁶

Saturday (evening)

APRIL 4TH IN AD 33 • 17TH OF NISAN

- The Sabbath ends at sunset
- Jesus' body lies in the tomb, guarded
- Jesus' female followers make plans to anoint His body

Sunday (pre-dawn)

APRIL 5TH IN AD 33 • 17TH OF NISAN

- Jesus' female followers leave for the tomb **just before sunrise**
- Jesus rises from the dead just before sunrise⁵³

- The authorities try to cover up the resurrection⁵⁹
- Peter encounters Jesus⁶⁰
- Cleopas and his companion encounter Jesus late in the day⁶¹
